TEAM INFORMATION

DATE: February 18

PLAYING RULES: NJB Rule book

FORMAT: Teams will be scheduled (2) games in pool play.

MEMBERSHIP: All players and coaches must be a current NJB member.

COACH SIT RULE: Will be enforced by the referees during the event.

AWARDS: Player medals to 1st and 2nd place teams in each pool.

SCHEDULE; Tournament games and results will be on Tourney Machine.

The fee is good at any NJB venue for the day

PLAYING RULE

The tournament will follow the NJB Rule Book.

- 1. Free Throws- Bonus will begin on the 10th foul in each half.
- 2 <u>Player Participation</u>- Every player must play one full continuous period in each half. Each player must sit out one period before the 5th period.
- 3. **(5)** player rule- The opposing team will be awarded points at the start of the game. **(5)** points awarded.
- 4. (6) player rule- The opposing team will be awarded points at the start of the game. (3) points awarded.
- 5. Bench- (1) Head coach and (2) assistant coaches allowed.
- 6. Player Advantage Rule- will be enforced during the tournament.
- 7. Pre-game conference- Head coaches and referees will meet prior to the game to cover playing rules and check the team picture.
- Sportsmanship- Any coach or spectator ejected from the game will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
 Site directors will have a zero tolerance during the event.
- Team picture- Each coach will bring their picture to each game.
 Individual players in uniform may be attached to the team picture.
- ADDING PLAYERS- This is not allowed.
 Teams may not add players to their regular season roster.

Player Advantage Rule 10 Players

One Player Advantage

If a team arrives with 10 players for the game - the coach with 10 players will choose the player on the opposing team to sit during the second and fourth periods. Player selection must be made prior to the second and fourth periods. Player participation will always supersede this rule.

10 VS 9 Players

<u>Two Player Advantage</u>

If a team arrives with 10 players for the game - the coach with 10 players will choose the two (2) players on the opposing team to sit during the second and fourth periods. Players selection must be made prior to the second and fourth periods. Player participation will always supersede this rule.

10 VS 8 Players

Three Player Advantage

If a team arrives with 10 players for the game - the coach with 10 players will choose the two (2) players on the opposing team to sit during the second and fourth periods. Players selection must be made prior to the second and fourth periods. Player participation will always supersede this rule.

10 VS 7 Players

IMPORTANT: All directors, scorekeepers, coaches and game referees shall try to prevent any potential player participation violations during the contest.

Player Advantage Rule does not apply with the Five (5) Player Rule or Six (6) Player Rule.



Team Pictures

- Your Chapter Director must sign the back of the team picture. Players must be in NJB uniform.
- Players who missed their picture day may submit an individual picture in NJB uniform for the Championship Series. It must be signed by your Chapter Director. Individual pictures must be attached to the team picture.
- Players will not be eligible to participate without the Chapter Director's signature. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- All players must be in full NJB uniform for all team and individual pictures.
- Do not send Pictures to NJB Headquarters.





TIE BREAKER:

In a situation where two (2) teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the winner. If more than two (2) teams are tied, a point differential (maximum of 13 points) will be applied. The differentials of all pool games are totaled and the teams are ranked accordingly. The team with the lowest total is eliminated, and will finish in third place. Then the winner from the remaining two (2) teams are determined by Head-to-Head competition.
